Also included in the curriculum will be two weeks work experience. The Prince's Trust XL Club is an informal club and is a two year programme with 12-15 members. It runs for three hours a week and members are encouraged to work together to achieve personal development goals relating to their education, training and future lives. XL clubs work towards The Prince's Trust XL Award accredited by ASDAN, giving club members awards in Problem Solving, Working with Others and Improving Own Learning, as well as recognising achievement in five key areas, including citizenship and entrepreneurship. Assessments for the XL club will be portfolio based.
